## Counselor in Training

Our **Counselor in Training (CIT)** program is for 12-13 year olds (going into 7<sup>th</sup>- 8<sup>th</sup> grade); kids who are in the transition years between being a camper and being an employee. The CIT program offers kids an introduction to the work environment of the Camp Counselor while offering them the opportunity to also be part of camp activities. They will learn skills that will benefit them as they move on to Junior Counselor positions in the future. This is the beginning training program for our future camp counselors.

Our CIT program gives 12-13 year olds the responsibility of having a job and also allows them the time to hang out with their friends. The program is designed for peer bonding and personal development. The CITs have job responsibilities in the morning and spend their afternoons participating in camp activities.
